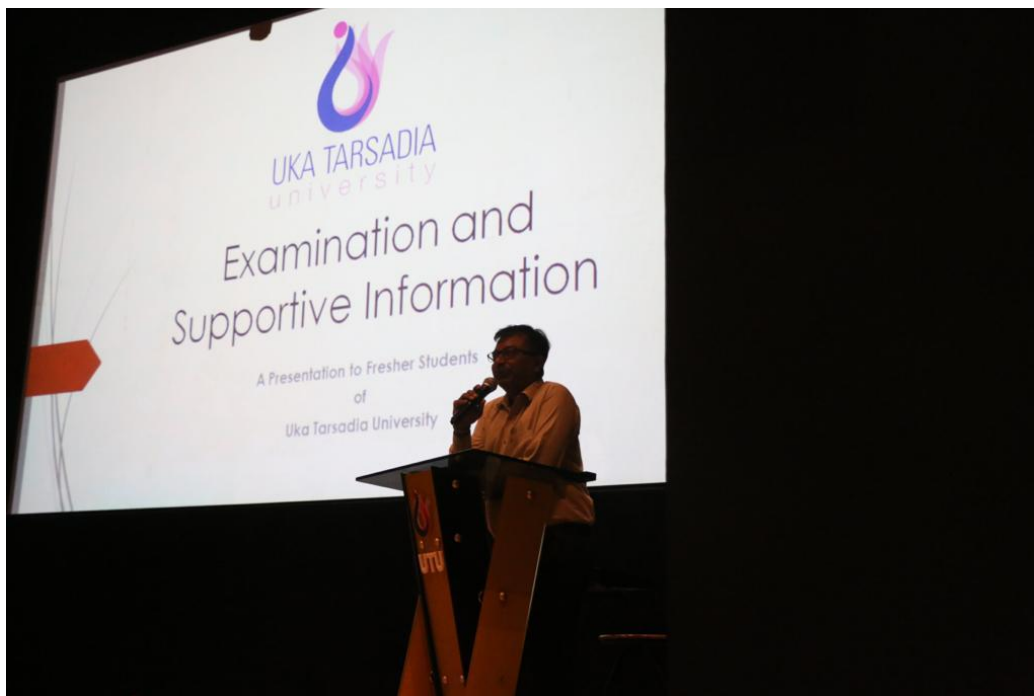

Special Visit to the Historical Place

After introducing the University campus in induction program, the students were made aware of the historical importance of the Bardoli village nearby which the university campus is situated. On 23rd of November the special visit was organized for newly admitted students for Bardoli Swaraj ashram and the Sardar Patel National Museum.

Bardoli Swaraj Ashram is the place where Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel used to stay during farmer's protest movements BARDOLI SATYAGRAH in 1928 against the British Government and from where he was organizing various meeting against intolerable increase in revenue. Bardoli became nationally famous and became a landmark on the road to India's independence and its leader Vallabhbhai became an immortal Sardar. Due to this movement Vallabhbhai Patel is addressed as "SARDAR".

To immortalize memories of Bardoli Farmers Movement, On January 22nd 1981 opened the museum for general public. This museum, introduces us with life and personality of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel along with descriptions of historical events of farmers movements of Bardoli of 1928.

The students Visited both the places. The students also met with Dr. Smt Niranjana Behn who is lifeline of the Ashram. Maaji Niranjana Behn has been living in the Ashram for 80 yrs. Her Gandhian parents had dedicated themselves to Sardar's work at Swaraj Ashram & she spent her childhood often in Sardar's company.

Through the exhibition of this museum, the students got a vivid picture of the memories of Sardar Shri Vallabhbhai Patel and at the same time try to understand the inspiring history of Bardoli.
